FINAL JUDGMENT

On March 22, 2011, the court called this case for trial. The Plaintiff, Gerald David Medow, appeared in person and through his attorney and announced ready for trial. The Defendant appeared through its attorney and announced ready for trial. The court empaneled and swore the jury, which heard the evidence and argument of counsel. The court submitted the Charge of the Court (which included questions, definitions, and instructions) to the jury. In response, the jury made findings that the court received, filed, and entered of record. The court hereby renders this judgment.

It is therefore ORDERED that the Plaintiff, Gerald David Medow, shall recover from Plano Lincoln-Mercury, Inc. d/b/a David McDavid Lincoln Mercury of Plano \$23,467.06 in actual damages, \$70,401.17 in additional damages for the Defendant's intentional violation of the Texas Deceptive Practices—Consumer Protection Act ("DTPA"), reasonable and necessary attorneys' fees of \$31,097.50 for the Plaintiff's attorneys' preparation and trial of this case, additional attorneys' fees of \$25,000.00 for successful defense of any appeal by the Defendant to the Dallas Court of Appeals, additional attorneys' fees of \$5,000.00 for drafting a response to a

petition for review for any appeal by the Defendant to the Texas Supreme Court, additional attorneys' fees of \$10,000.00 for full briefing on the merits for any appeal by the Defendant to the Texas Supreme Court if the Defendant's petition for review is granted, all court costs, pre-judgment interest at the rate of five percent (5%) per annum on the total of actual damages, viz. \$23,467.06, from September 4, 2009 through the day before the date of this judgment, and post-judgment interest at the rate of five percent (5%) per annum on the total of these amounts from the date of this judgment until the amount is paid in full.

It is further ORDERED that the Plaintiff shall be allowed such writs and processes as may be necessary in the enforcement and collection of this judgment.

All relief not expressly granted is denied. This judgment disposes of all issues and parties in this case and is final for purposes of appeal.
